

## St. Peter the Apostle Altar Society 2017

The St Peter the Apostle Altar Society does a magnificent job of preparing funeral dinners. We receive numerous compliments from the family and friends about our menu, variety of salads and cakes; and hospitality. The funeral committee is appreciative of everyone who takes the time to prepare food for a dinner when requested. Without the time and talent of our St. Peter ladies we couldn't continue this tradition.

Please utilize these guidelines when making a cake or salad for a funeral dinner.

### Food drop off

Guild members can deliver their item to St. Peter School the day of the funeral by 9:30 a.m. School doors open at 7 a.m. Please mark your item – **Funeral Dinner**. There will be carts inside the front school doors for your food or you can take the food into the office. Cakes only can be delivered to Patti Becker's house if arrangements are made by the guild member the night prior to the funeral. Your guild captain will inform you if there is a cookie reception after the rosary. If so, you will have a small time frame to deliver your food item to the school that evening. Not all rosaries have cookie receptions.

### Cakes

- Cake size is to be a 9" x 13", Bundt or 10" circle cake to serve a **minimum of 15 adults**.
- We need a variety of cakes so please inform your guild captain what you are sending.
- **Do not** cut the cake.
- Place your name on pan if you want it back. It can be picked up the day following the funeral in the south cry room closet.

### Salads

- The salad needs to serve a **minimum of 20 people**. **Our salads are frequently too small**. Please inform your guild captain what you are sending to ensure a good variety for the funeral. No utensils are needed.
- Here are a few suggested salads however we are always welcome to your ideas: Broccoli/Cauliflower, Garlic, Ramen noodle, Coleslaw, Jello w fruit, Cool Whip fluffy ones, Waldorf, Watergate, or mixed fruit. A layered lettuce salad is acceptable.
- **Unacceptable** salad items are: relish trays, deviled eggs, and lettuce or pasta salads.
- Place your name on the salad bowl if you want it back. It can be picked up the day following the funeral in the south cry room closet.
